



A service to support you in the community following prison release

This mentoring service is for those who are subject to Probation Board supervision and assessed as medium/high ACE on release from prison. It offers early contact through and beyond the gate and intensive support in the community. It aims to help you stay out of trouble.

- It is delivered through a new partnership between the Probation Board for Northern Ireland (PBNI) and NIACRO. The Project is currently funded to run until March 2016.
- Its effectiveness will be measured by your feedback and any positive changes which took place as well as any recall to prison.
- Your mentor will introduce themselves to you up to four weeks before release.
- They will meet you on your release date and every day during that first week.
- Contact will continue up to 12 weeks after release.
- You will be supported in relation to accommodation, employment / training, money management/benefits, family issues , addictions or other issues which will help you resettle
- This will support work you are completing with your Probation Officer.
